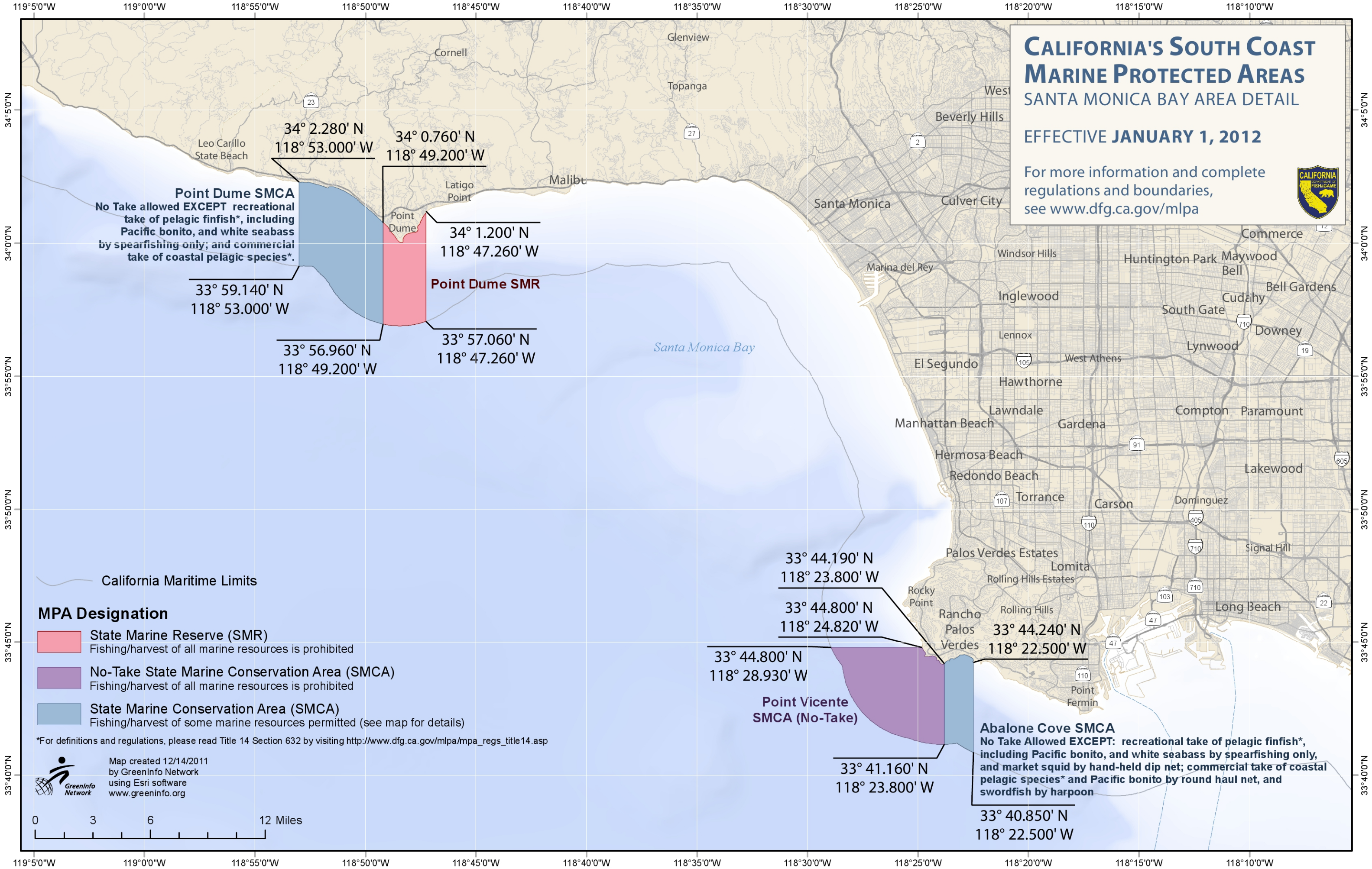


CALIFORNIA'S SOUTH COAST MARINE PROTECTED AREAS SANTA MONICA BAY AREA DETAIL
