CALIFORNIA HAS ONE OF THE HIGHEST LEVELS OF RECREATIONAL BOATING ACTIVITY IN THE NATION. WITH OVER THREE MILLION RECREATIONAL BOATS IN CALIFORNIA, EVERY EFFORT TO FOLLOW THE ACTIONS BELOW IS A SIGNIFICANT STEP TOWARDS PRESERVING THE WATERWAYS IN THIS BEAUTIFUL STATE.

-  **PREVENT OILY DISCHARGE FROM THE BILGE.**
-  **SPILL-PROOF YOUR OIL CHANGES AND FUELING.**
-  **DO NOT USE SOAP TO DISPERSE FUEL AND OIL SPILLS.**
-  **MINIMIZE BOAT CLEANING AND MAINTENANCE IN THE WATER.**
-  **REDUCE TOXIC DISCHARGES FROM BOTTOM PAINTS.**
-  **DISPOSE OF HAZARDOUS WASTE PROPERLY.**
-  **PLAN AHEAD! MANAGE SEWAGE WASTES PROPERLY AND USE SEWAGE PUMPOUTS**
-  **STOW IT, DO NOT THROW IT!
REDUCE, REUSE AND RECYCLE**
-  **REDUCE GREY WATER DISCHARGES.**
-  **DO NOT SPREAD AQUATIC INVASIVE SPECIES.
CLEAN, DRAIN, AND DRY YOUR BOAT.**
